



Medication Policy

Camp Policy regarding Medication. Read carefully:

Prescription Medications Must Have	Labeling
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete name of guest • Date prescription filled • Expiration date • Name and address of dispensing pharmacy • Name of physician prescribing medication • Directions for use/precautions (if any) storage (if any) 	<p>Medications must be checked for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medications must be in their original containers • All medications must be labeled correctly

1. All guests must be screened by Health administration upon entering camp.
2. Upon arrival at camp, guests must provide **all** medications (prescription and non-prescription) to the Nurse at the time of camp admission screening.
3. All medications must be labeled as previously indicated.
4. Loose, unlabeled medications will not be accepted.
5. Do not mix different medications in the same bottle.
6. All medications (prescription and non-prescription) must have an expiration date.
7. Times of administration of (prescription and non-prescription) medications will be arranged with the Camp Nurse.
8. Guests may not have any medications (prescription and non-prescription) in their possession unless previously agreed/arranged by Camp Nurse.
