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REQUEST FOR BID- (RFB)-Quest, Inc.

Life Concepts, Inc. dba Quest, Inc., is seeking bids from suitably qualified and experienced firms with the intent to install flooring at the Quest North Adult Day Training Center for people with disabilities. The installation includes: (1) removing vinyl baseboard and preparing concrete floors, (2) installing (float/glue) 11,215 square feet of COREtec Pro Plus Floating Floor, and (3) reinstalling baseboards and touching paint on walls (if necessary).

Quest North is located at 210 W. Fourth Street, Apopka, FL 32703. The proposed project is funded by an Orange County Capital Improvement Project – Community Development Block Grant. The project – the aforementioned installation of flooring at Quest North – must meet and/or exceed the standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and be in accordance with Federal Community Development Block Grant programs, as may be amended and other applicable laws and regulations.

All bidders must be registered with Sam.gov and have an active DUNS number. Bids will be considered from professional firms that demonstrate experience and success in installing floors at ADA facilities as well as experience in adhering with all applicable Federal requirements as stated in the Special Provisions. Procurement is by sealed bids (formal advertising). Bids are publicly solicited and a firm-fixed price contract (lump sum or unit price) is awarded to the responsive bidder whose bid, confirming with all the material items and conditions of the invitation for bids is the lowest price.

A pre-bid conference to discuss this Project will be held on Friday, October 27 at 3:00 p.m. at Quest North – 210 W. Fourth Street, Apopka, FL 32703. Information related to the pre-bid conference will be posted on Quest's website.

Bidding will close on Friday, November 3 at noon and all submitted bids will be opened and reviewed at 3:00 p.m. at Quest North, 210 W. Fourth Street, Apopka, FL 32703.
