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REQUEST FOR BID- (RFB)-Quest, Inc.

Life Concepts, Inc., dba Quest Inc., is seeking bids from suitably qualified and experienced firms with the intent to perform a renovation of several areas of the Quest North Adult Day Training Center for disabled persons (ADT). These renovations are to include: (1) retrofit of an existing room to a public gallery, (2) Conversion of warehouse to useable space and (3) HVAC installation within warehouse area(s). Quest North is located at 210 W. Fourth Street, Apopka, FL 32703. The proposed project is funded by a \$100,000 Orange County Capital Improvement Project-Community Development Block Grant. The project shall mean the aforementioned renovations and expansions to Quest North must: meet and/or exceed the standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and be in accordance with Federal Community Development Block Grant programs, as may be amended and other applicable federal laws and regulations.

Bids will be considered from professional firms that demonstrate experience and success in conducting master planning and renovations for roof and ADA facilities as well as experience in adhering with all applicable Federal requirements as stated in the Special Provisions. Procurement is by sealed bids (formal advertising). Bids are publicly solicited and a firm-fixed price contract (lump sum or unit price) is awarded to the responsive bidder whose bid, confirming with all the material items and conditions of the invitation for bids is the lowest price.

A pre-bid conference to discuss this Project will be held on Friday, February 24 at 3:00 pm at Quest North, 210 W. Fourth Street, Apopka, FL 32703. Information related to the pre-bid conference will be posted on Quest's website.
