“This was a difficult decision for our organization as our Quest Shreds team members have worked hard to build strong business relationships and opportunities with clients throughout Central Florida.”, says John Gill, President and CEO of Quest, Inc.

Quest Shreds is a stand-alone, commercial shredding business that is AAA certified by the National Association for Information Destruction (NAID). Quest Shreds was established as a part of the organizations focus on social entrepreneurship, to generate income for Quest, Inc. in support of its mission and to provide meaningful employment opportunities for the individuals served by Quest.

“Quest Shreds has struggled to gain a foothold within an extremely competitive, commoditized industry that has seen slow growth since Quest Shreds began operations in 2012.” said Gill.

Quest Shreds will cease all operations on February 28, 2016.
